Contrary to Senator Boikess' assertion, as I explained at the last ExCom meeting, this is in fact a settled matter of law. The documentation is overwhelming. Since I can't summarize quickly in my own words, you are free to print any/all of these articles. I have about a dozen more that all say the same thing.
