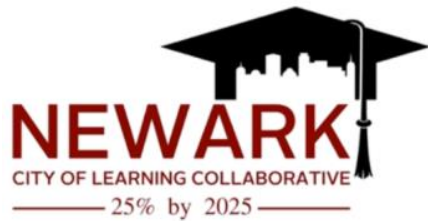

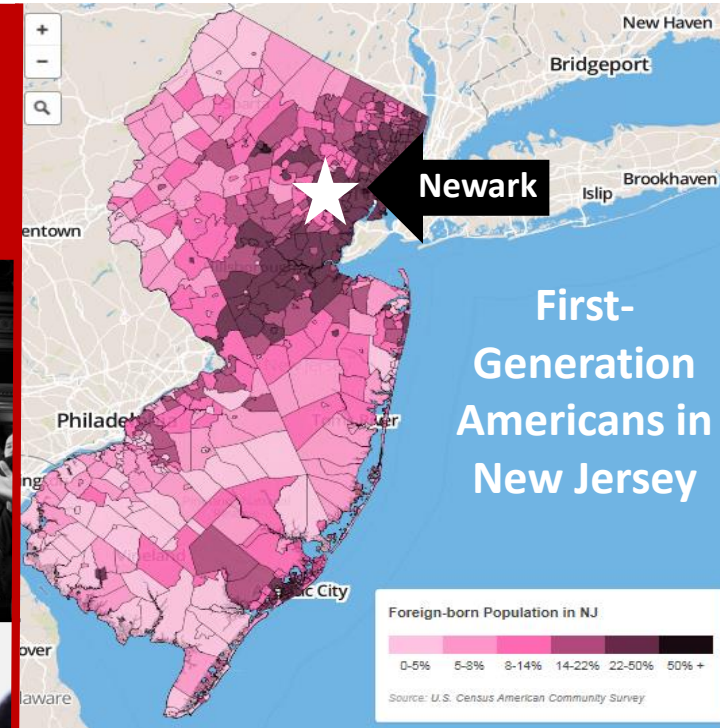

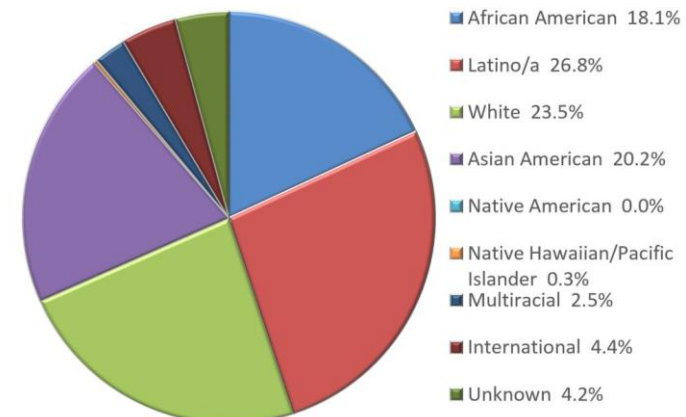

Pathways to America's Future in Newark

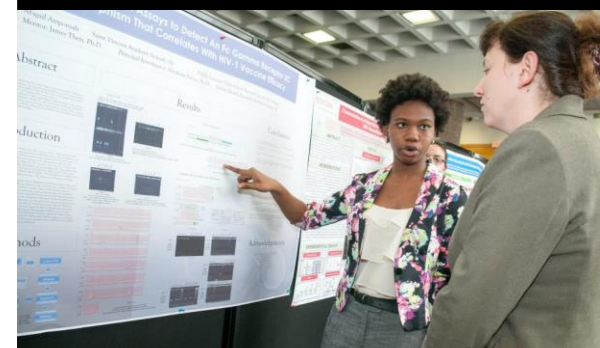
- Undergraduate enrollment up 13.2% since 2013
- 637 RU-N to the TOP scholars in 2016
- 86 HLLC residential scholars
- Newark resident enrollment up 23% from 2015, 47% from 2013
- NJCC transfer enrollment up 21% since 2013
 - 43% of NJCC transfers are from Essex, Hudson & Passaic CCs
- 211 GSLSAMP Scholars at RU-N, 16% from Bridges to Baccalaureate Program (B2B)
 - 1,000 B2B students in 5 NJCCs that are HSIs
- 19 TheDream.US Scholars at RU-N
- 14 Cooperman Scholars at RU-N
- 56 Rutgers Future Scholars-Newark at RU-N

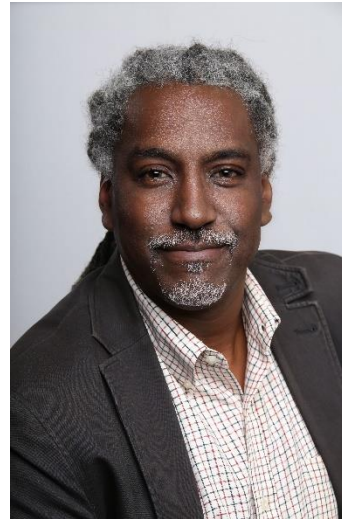

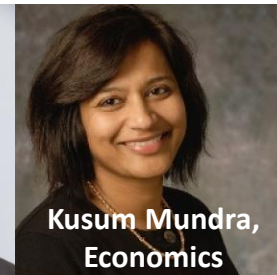
HLLC Entering Class 2016

- Includes students who are parents, formerly incarcerated, formerly homeless, formerly in foster care

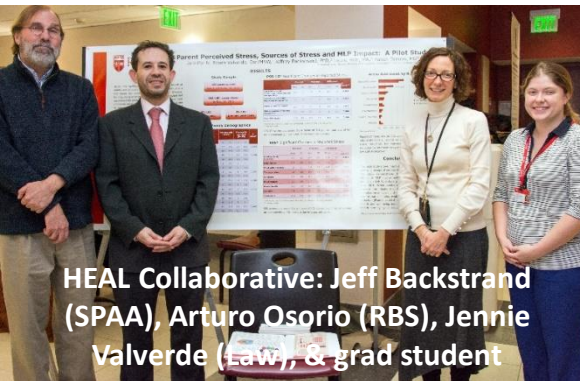

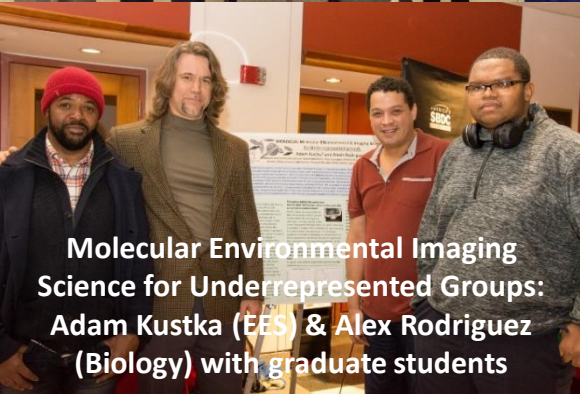
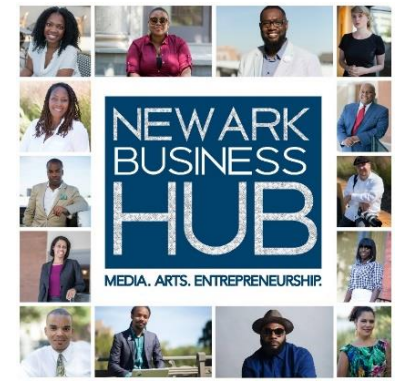
