










Rutgers–Newark Demographics





- Undergraduate enrollment up 13.2% since 2013
- 637 RU-N to the TOP scholars in 2016
- 86 HLLC residential scholars
- Newark resident enrollment up 23% from 2015, 47% from 2013
- NJCC transfer enrollment up 21% since 2013

 43% of NJCC transfers are from Essex, Hudson & Passaic CCs
- 211 GSLSAMP Scholars at RU-N, 16% from Bridges to Baccalaureate Program (B2B)
 0 1,000 B2B students in 5 NJCCs that are HSIs
- 19 TheDream.US Scholars at RU-N




