

PROPOSED RESOLUTION APPROVING REVISIONS TO THE UNIVERSITY'S CODE OF STUDENT CONDUCT POLICY (UNIVERSITY POLICY SECTION 10.2.11)

WHEREAS, the current version of University Policy Section 10.2.11, Code of Student Conduct ("the Code") was approved by the Board of Governors of Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, by Resolution dated October 14, 2015 and has been in effect since that date; and

WHEREAS, on September 21, 2016, the Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs approved changes to University Policy Section 10.2.14, Alcohol and Other Drugs Policy for Students, including a provision that disciplinary fines may be imposed for alcohol and drug violations and the addition of Section VII: Medical Amnesty from University Code of Student Conduct Violations; and

WHEREAS, the amendment to University Policy Section 10.2.14 necessitates revisions to the Code in order to incorporate language regarding disciplinary fines for alcohol and drug violations as well as the addition of Section X(F): Community Review Board Procedures and Section XV: Medical Amnesty; and

WHEREAS, Senior Vice President of Academic Affairs Barbara A. Lee and relevant Student Affairs officials at Rutgers University–New Brunswick, Rutgers University–Newark, Rutgers University–Camden and Rutgers Biomedical Health Sciences have reviewed and approved the revisions to Code; and

WHEREAS, on September 21, 2016 the Committee on Academic and Student Affairs of the Board of Governors reviewed the revised Code and recommended its approval by the Board of Governors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, upon the recommendation of the Committee on Academic and Student Affairs, the Board of Governors of Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, approves and adopts the attached revised Code of Student Conduct, Policy Section 10.2.11, effective immediately.
