SUBJECT: Change of Registration Analysis
Please find attached the change of registration analysis for the Fall 2001 semester. The following should be noted:

- The number of sections offered is still increasing faster than enrollment growth. See page 2
- Many courses were dropped at the end of the drop period making them available for students to add. See page 3
- Fewer sections are "open" at the end of the add period this semester which should be expected since the drop period ended before the add period. See page 5
- More students and a higher percentage of students were able to register for the courses they selected for the Fall 2001 semester. There is a significant increase in the percentage of students that were able to register for every course requested (not necessarily the specific section they wanted). See pages 6 and 7
- The number of large sections (40 or more students) remained about the same in Fall 2001 (15.9\%) as compared with Fall 2000 ( $15.7 \%$ ) but lower than Fall 1999 (16.0\%). See pages 8, 9 and 10

## Courses Dropped After The Add Period

- 2,901 Number of courses students dropped in the second week of classes (September 11-17, 2001)
- 5,533 Number of courses students dropped the last two days of the drop period (day 6 and 7 -September 9 and 10,2001 )
- 2,433 Number of courses students dropped in the 8th, 9th and 10th day (September 11, 12 and 13, $2001-$ - 1,056 dropped in the 8th day)
- 5,948 Number of courses dropped after the second week of classes (September 18 - October 29, 2001).

NOTE: The 5,533 courses dropped the last two days of the drop period were available for students to add since the add period was extended to include the 6th, 7th and 8th days.

- 4,848 Courses added the 6th, 7th and 8th day (September 9, 10 and 11, 2001)

## Courses Dropped After The Add Period

- 3,777 Number of courses students dropped in the second week of classes (September 12-18, 2000)
- 3,751 Number of courses students dropped after the second week of classes (September 19 - October 30, 2000)
- 7,528 Total courses dropped after the add period.
- Since these courses were dropped after the add period, they were not available for students to add. If the add/drop period were the same length, 7,528 "seats" in classes would have been available to students.
